What's Hot—New Sanyo Camera

We have a new Sanyo camera available with 4 Megapixels resolution. You can record directly to a SD Memory Card or a 2.5" External HDD without having to use a PC as well as being able to access the recorded images via the internet. Security News

New Scanner picks fake IDs A fake driver's license may fool a bouncer at a club or the guy at the local liquor shop but it won't fool this new scanner. New Zealand company MillenTech has designed a handheld infrared scanner that scans Driver's Licenses and 18+ cards and identifies the bogus from the bona fide. The scanner reads security features like watermarks and near infra-red ink that are not visible to the naked eye. It is currently being trialed in Wellington.
