## Security News - CCTV Guidelines

The Privacy Commissioner has recently released guidelines on the use of closed-circuit television systems (CCTV). "CCTV has an important role to play in detecting and prosecuting crime, and even deterring some types of crime. But this does not need to be at the expense of privacy." The new guidance offers practical advice on deciding whether CCTV is needed, planning the system properly, selecting the appropriate technology and positioning of cameras, making employees, customers and others aware that CCTV is operating, storing and retaining the images, and giving people access to images of them.
